## First-time, First-Enrolled Enrollment Outcomes

## Completion Rates for Year End: 2019

According to the Federal Title IV Higher Education Amendments of 1998, schools must track the rate at which it takes the school's students to complete their post-secondary education. The cohort of students used to calculate this rate is restricted, by these Amendments, to students who are starting at the school their postsecondary education for the first time since high school. These Amendments also specify that the measurements allow first-time enrollees $150 \%$ of the scheduled program length to complete it. As the Certificate Program is three-year program, the calculation of these rates covers four-and-half years. While the calculation of these rates for USIS students covers one-and-half years. Current measurements for the academic year ending 2018 show:

Certificate Programs (3 year) - 100\% of first-time, first-enrolled students who enrolled in fall 2014 completed the program as scheduled at the end of the spring 2018 semester.

Independent-Study Program - 89\% of first-time, first-enrolled students who enrolled in fall 2017 completed the program as scheduled at the end of the spring 2018 semester.

## Retention Rates

The Retention Rate for first-time, first-enrolled Certificate Students who started their studies in the fall 2014 semester is $100 \%$ as nine of the nine students re-enrolled in the fall 2015 semester.

The Retention Rate for first-time, first-enrolled Independent-Study Students who started their studies in the fall 2014 semester is $89 \%$ as 8 of the 9 students attended the spring 15 semester.
